APPLICATION PROCESS

Step 1: Contact

- Contact with school office by phone, email, or website
- Initial information given to parent

Step 2: Application

- Application can be picked up from the school office or downloaded from the school website
- Parent fills out application completely (1 application per family)
- Once the application is filled out, it can be turned in to our school office
- Application fee must be turned in with the application:
 - \$25.00 per family
 - Non-refundable
 - *Registration fee is due upon acceptance into Legacy Christian Academy*

Step 3: Interview

- Once the application has been reviewed by administration, parent will be contacted to set up an interview meeting with the prospective family
- Interview meeting will take place with the prospective family, school board, and administration

Step 4: Review

- School Board will review the application and interview notes
- School Board will determine acceptance of new students

Step 5: Acceptance

- Parents will be notified of the School Board's decision regarding acceptance/denial of new students

Step 6: Registration

- If new student is accepted, parents must fill out and turn in Registration Packet (located on website), registration fees, and book fees
- New student information, such as school supplies, calendar, and uniform ordering information will be given to parents

Please Note:

- Students are accepted into LCA based upon previous academic, spiritual, and social records.
- *All students are accepted on a probationary status.*
- All necessary forms must be signed by parent/guardian (and student if applicable), before enrollment into LCA is considered complete.
 - This includes reading and signing a "Handbook Statement" that you have read, understand, and agree to abide by the school handbook.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

RESPECT: Be respectful of ALL authority

- Say “yes ma’am,” “no ma’am,” and “yes sir,” “no sir”
- STAND quietly when an adult enters the classroom and wait to be seated until permission is given
- Any form of disrespect will not be tolerated

EFFORT: Do your best

- Pay attention in class and work hard
- Get ALL of your work done – complete all of the steps, turn it in on time (includes: classwork, homework, projects, etc.)
- Speak clearly and with appropriate volume
- Don’t interrupt others
- Participate in class
- BE PREPARED for every class – the discussion and the work

ATTITUDE/GRATITUDE: Be positive and thankful

- Don’t complain or grumble
- Say “thank you” to your teachers/staff
- Say “thank you” to your parents

KINDNESS: Be kind to EVERYONE

- Don’t tease or call names
- Help each other
- Work together to have a great class
- Don’t be bossy & don’t tattle – worry about yourself

QUIET: Keep the classrooms/hallways a quiet place to learn

- Classrooms
 - Stay in your seat
 - Raise your hand
 - Do not talk without permission
- Hallways
 - No running, pushing/shoving, horseplaying
 - Keep the hallways quiet

CLEANLINESS:

- Keep all student areas clean: desk, floor around desk, student cubbies/lockers, classrooms, hallways
- Lunchroom: throw away trash, clean your table, and floor area
- Older students: may be expected to wipe down tables, sweep/mop floor, take out trash
- All students are expected to help keep the school clean, and may be given classroom chores to help accomplish this

HOMEWORK:

- Finish all of your homework every day
- Turn in homework assignments on time; Plan study time
- HOMEWORK NOTEBOOKS
 - Must have the date & assignment recorded
 - Must be signed or initialed by the parent daily
- Parent/Teacher Communication forms must be signed and returned

UNIFORMS:

- Adhere to all components of school uniform at all times
- Uniforms must be worn properly

Any violation (including, but not limited to) of these expectations will result in a discipline report.

Discipline Structure

- Students may be given a discipline report for any violation of school expectations, or any violation that the staff deems against our school standards of Christian behavior
- Citations
 - Most offenses will be assigned 1, 3, or 5 citations (certain offenses may receive 10 citations)
 - Accrual of 15 citations will result in a lunch detention
 - May be removed by completing chores on the school property
- ISS (in-school suspension)
 - 2 lunch detentions will result in an ISS
 - School Board is notified
- OSS (out-of-school suspension)
 - 2 lunch detentions following an ISS will result in an OSS
 - School Board meeting will be held with parent and student
